2. Minutes of last meeting was held on Tuesday 24 April and been circulated previously by email and were signed by AK this evening, as a true record.

3. Reports –

Tesco – the new fascia has been installed and the Clay Cross Town Centre map has been reinstated onto this.

Clay Cross on the Beach –

AK is liaising with the council re permission to use the car park again for the two days and any licence we would require. Events committee is in the process of being set up and a date arranged for the first meeting.

4. Current Issues and Projects.

Events Meeting – a date will be set and AK will email all members informing them when the next meeting is set up to get ready to organise Clay Cross on the Beach, probably a Wednesday pm. Some members have already expressed an interest to help and AHo will contact these.

5. New Members Joining – There have not been any new members join this month. There is vacancy for 2 annual members (£120 per year)

6. Newsletter, website update and facebook – SteveS is creating the Privacy Policy for the website, which is a requirement of the updated GDPR (data protection). AHo mentioned that we will also need consent from members to contact them via email in the future. As far as we can see we will not need to pay an annual subscription to the ICO as there is a clause which excludes clubs and voluntary organisations.

7. Report on financial position – AK advised the balance at the bank was £2,539.50 per the last bank statement at 13 April 2018 and that since then there will have been credits of the usual monthly £10 standing orders from the directory subscribing members together with a £50 paid direct from one member and annual subscriptions from other members which will have more or less covered the recent £600 payment to Wings for the April/May Newsletter. There are no outstanding invoices for payment at the current time.
