WELCOME to this autumn issue of the Clay Cross Town Centre Group News.

Autumn days are now with us, along with the changing colours of the town's green spaces and nearby parks. The coming months still have much to offer as the town centre awaits the imminent 'spade in the ground' start to its regeneration project of road reconnection, pedestrianising of Market Street and new town square.

Since the last newsletter the Town Centre Regeneration Scheme has made further progress with the securing of the Broadleys site and the pre-commencement works of archaeology and bat surveys being completed bringing the start of the Baileys Square works, which will be at the heart of the re-development, closer to its delivery stage.

Also Inside Limited as the preferred contractor for the town centre project build now has its information hub in Market Street open to the public on weekdays 9am to 4pm.

In other regeneration news, construction of the new Clay Cross Active leisure centre and community hub at Sharley Park has made further progress and the latest news and pictures can be found in the July update at the following link <https://claycrossactive.co.uk/2024/07/24/july-update-2024/>

In addition the Town Deal's Low Carbon Challenge Fund has recently made a grant award of £100,000 to a local business to help towards its strategy of achieving net zero emissions.

In more sombre news, group member Peter Yates, who was the proprietor of Clay Cross Airguns on Market Street, passed away unexpectedly in July. Peter had been trading in Market Street for the majority of the last 20 years. With his friendly disposition Peter was well liked by the local community and was always supportive of town centre group events. He will be missed by many.

Sadly, we also have to record that Councillor Geoffrey Morley who was Chair of the Parish Council, Chair of North East Derbyshire District Council and a member of the Clay Cross Town Deal Board passed away in July. He was an active member of the local community and was involved with the running of Clay Cross Social Centre, which is one of our group members. He too will be missed by many.

Turning to the traditional town areas of Market Street and High Street these continue to host a variety of independent traders including those who have been in the town for many years such as family run firm T Nutt & Sons flooring centre, Taylors Corn Stores for artisan flour for baking and bread



making, and pet and gardening products. There is also Smiths Creamland Ices whose ice cream, often licked never beaten, is produced on site and Clay Cross DIY who have a comprehensive range of household products and friendly staff who are always willing to help find what you are looking for. You will also find florists Bluebells and Balloons, who are always helpful in selecting the right arrangement for the occasion. There is a Post Office which as well as offering traditional postal services and being a convenience store, also provides foreign currency exchange, bill payment and top ups, passport applications and vehicle tax renewals.

There are a number of cafes, eateries, and sandwich shops which provide lunchtime refreshment and for a more extensive dining experience which operate during lunchtime and in the evening there is The Three Horseshoes on Market Street and the George at Clay Lane/High Street crossroads.

Other traders include Music Memorabilia Beck's Rock Box, run by popular music enthusiast Ian Bexton, which has an extensive selection of yesteryear vinyl records and related rock band souvenirs and unique gifts shop Hygge Emporium.

Professional service firms include Bradley Morrell Solicitors, Estate Agents Pinewood Properties who offer a sales and letting service, The Body Health Centre for sports massage, physiotherapy and chiropractic services, and long established law firm Cleaver Thompson Solicitors whose services include wills, probate and lasting powers of attorney.

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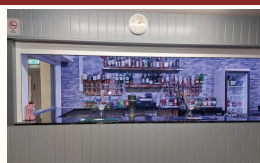

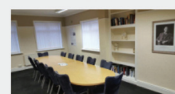


The Charitque
